

Indian River Grower's Market 2010 Rules

1. The market will be for residents of the following counties: Antrim, Alpena, Charlevoix, Cheboygan, Emmet, Montmorency, Otsego and Presque Isle. Resident growers will grow over 90% of their own product. All vendors will complete a Vendor Application before attending the market. Copies of all appropriate licenses/permits must be attached to the application.
2. The market will be open from 9:00am to 1:00pm every Saturday and 3:00pm to 7:00pm every Wednesday from June 19, 2010 thru October 30, 2010. Vendors must maintain and leave their stall and the surrounding area in a clean and orderly fashion including accumulated garbage throughout the day.
3. Vendors will conduct themselves in a courteous fashion, no foul language will be tolerated, and children shall not be left unattended. Animals are not allowed at the Grower's Market.
4. Vendors participating in Project Fresh agree to comply with program rules. Vendors who are interested in participating in Project Fresh please contact: MSU Extension, 231-627-8815
5. Vendors are allowed to sell meat, dairy and eggs at the Grower's Market. Photocopies of all relevant licenses, from the state or federal agencies are required by the Grower's Market. Vendor must be in compliance with county, MDA and USDA regulations. Photocopies of all licenses are required to be shown at the Grower's Market and copies must be included with the vendor application.
6. Vendors are allowed to sell processed items such as honey, jams, jellies, dried fruits, dried chillies, salsas, herbal products and baked goods. The vendor must obtain all required licenses from the state and county that are required to process and package such goods. Photocopies of all licenses are required to be shown at the Grower's Market and copies must be included with the vendor application.
7. Vendors are allowed to sell handcrafted items but these items cannot exceed 50% of your booth space and items must be made from products produced on the vendors own farm.
8. All customer complaints with products must be resolved by the vendor.
9. Anyone not complying with these rules or creating disturbances or disruptions as determined by the Grower's Market Steering Committee will be suspended from the market for a period of thirty days without refund. If a second offense occurs that vendor will not be allowed to attend the market again for the duration of the season.
10. These rules apply to all vendors and all employees/representatives of the vendors.
