

2018 KAYAK BIKE BIATHLON

- The 11th Annual Kayak Bike Biathlon takes place on Sunday, July 22, 2018 from 9AM to 11AM.
- Check-in begins at 8 AM at DeVoe Public Beach in Indian River.
- The event is limited to the first 100 registered participants.
- Participants enter for fun, fitness, and/or competition.
- The course begins with 2.24 miles of kayaking on the beautiful and historic Inland Waterway (Burt Lake and the Indian River).
- The course continues with 11.68 miles of bicycling on the scenic North Central State Trail, which is crushed lime-stone (not recommended for extremely narrow tires).
- The start is at DeVoe Beach at 9AM. The transition from kayaking to biking is also at DeVoe Beach. The finish-line is near the Chamber of Commerce Building. Refreshments, awards, and prizes are back at DeVoe Beach. The award ceremony begins at 11AM.
- Registration includes free T-shirt and free refreshments.
- Beautiful wood plaques will be awarded to the top finishers in each age/gender category.
- All participants will have a chance to win up to \$1000 in donated prizes.
- All proceeds this year will go to the construction of the new Burt Lake Bike Trail and the grooming of the Wildwood Hills Pathway Cross Country Ski Trails.
- Participants must provide bicycle and proper helmet.
- Participants must provide kayak with paddle, and Coast Guard approved life-jacket .
