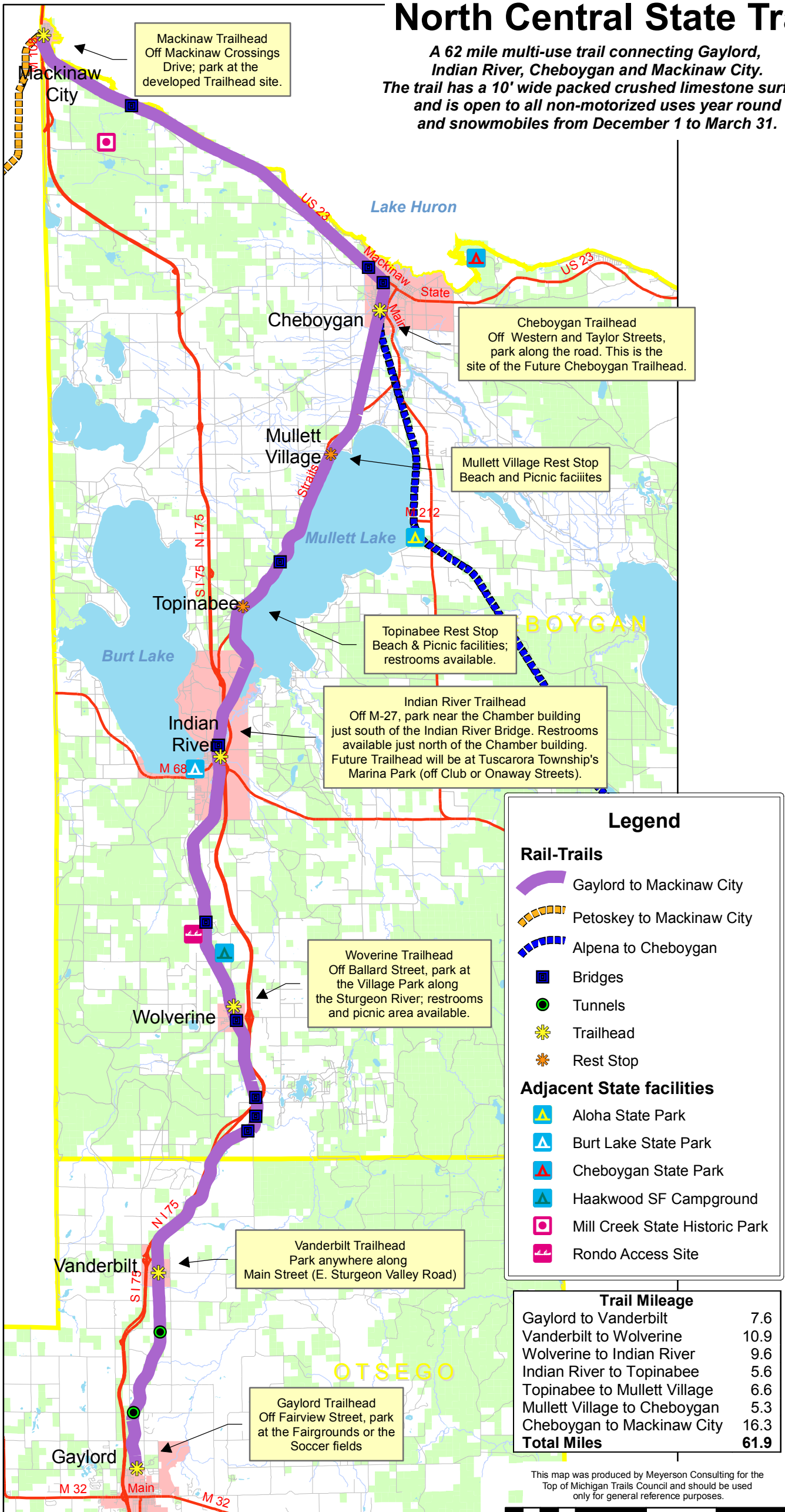


North Central State Trail

A 62 mile multi-use trail connecting Gaylord, Indian River, Cheboygan and Mackinaw City. The trail has a 10' wide packed crushed limestone surface and is open to all non-motorized uses year round and snowmobiles from December 1 to March 31.



Mackinaw Trailhead
Off Mackinaw Crossings Drive; park at the developed Trailhead site.

Cheboygan Trailhead
Off Western and Taylor Streets, park along the road. This is the site of the Future Cheboygan Trailhead.

Mullett Village Rest Stop
Beach and Picnic facilities

Topinabee Rest Stop
Beach & Picnic facilities; restrooms available.

Indian River Trailhead
Off M-27, park near the Chamber building just south of the Indian River Bridge. Restrooms available just north of the Chamber building. Future Trailhead will be at Tuscarora Township's Marina Park (off Club or Onaway Streets).

Wolverine Trailhead
Off Ballard Street, park at the Village Park along the Sturgeon River; restrooms and picnic area available.

Vanderbilt Trailhead
Park anywhere along Main Street (E. Sturgeon Valley Road)

Gaylord Trailhead
Off Fairview Street, park at the Fairgrounds or the Soccer fields
